### How to reach Ravenna: some details about your travel

The airports of Bologna (G.Marconi), Forlì (G.Ridolfi), Rimini (Miramare), and Venice (Marco Polo), run main line and charter services between the major Italian and European cities.

It takes between one and two hours to reach Ravenna by car or train from Bologna, about two hours by car from Venice and under an hour from either Forlì or Rimini.

A fast and efficient rail service links the North of Italy with the Centre-South by the Rimini-Ferrara, Ravenna-Bologna and Ravenna-Florence lines.

The best suggestion is to reach Bologna airport. Take the bus (each 15 minutes) to Bologna Central Train Station and then get a train (1 hour ) to reach Ravenna.
